Do you use music in your business?

Most businesses that play music need a licence from APRA AMCOS and a separate licence from PPCA (for playing of recorded music or music videos). APRA AMCOS and PPCA will launch a partnership called OneMusic Australia in 2018 to provide a one-stop shop for your licensing needs. To assist in an easy migration from the current two licence requirement to a single licence, we and the PPCA now share *non-confidential* client information, such as your licence commencement date (where relevant depending on use), to ensure both organisations hold the same accurate data in connection with your account.
